

## Cities of Louisville and Wrens Select Meridian Waste as Solid Waste Provider

## Service in Both Cities to Begin September 1

AUGUSTA, Ga. (June 28, 2019) – Meridian Waste, an integrated, non-hazardous solid waste services company, was awarded solid waste services contracts by both the City of Wrens and the City of Louisville at recent council meetings. The fee for solid waste services will be paid by the cities to Meridian Waste and remain as a line item on residential units' water bills.
