Meridian Waste Announces Winners of Second Annual Earth Day Coloring Contest

In the age category from five to seven years old, the winner is Siddharth Pradeep of Princeton, N.J., and in the age category from eight to 10 years old, the winner is Lily Behe of Webster, N.Y.

"When we developed the coloring contest in late 2019, we never imagined the experience would be a pandemic activity. And now, two contests later, we have given children a stimulating, creative outlet to look forward to," said Wally Hall, CEO of Meridian Waste. "It's been our pleasure to offer the contest to all children across the United States. This year's winners come from outside of our current operating footprint. However, we believe it is our

responsibility to help educate and inform children about the role everyone has in protecting our environment."
