## Second Lunenburg Landfill Fall Fest A Success

Lunenburg County, Va. - (October 31, 2022) – <u>Meridian Waste</u>, an integrated, non-hazardous solid waste services company, and its Lunenburg Landfill at 45 Landfill Road, celebrated the second Fall Fun Fest on Saturday, October 29, with 170 members of the community.

The clean energy project is expected to be completed in Fall 2023.
