### Service

### What are my days of service?

Service includes once-a-week garbage. A sticker will be placed on your garbage cart listing your collection day.

### When will I receive my garbage cart?

You will receive your garbage cart prior to September 1.

### How is billing handled?

The City is responsible for the billing and collection of all solid waste fees.

### **Waste Collection**

Collection Day: Carts should be curbside by 6:00 AM on your collection day.

ATTENTION: All waste materials must be **INSIDE** the provided 95-gallon cart. Any items placed outside the cart will NOT be collected.

Hazardous waste will **NOT** be collected.

**Bulk Goods:** Bulk goods will be collected by the City on a pre-approved or prescheduled day. Meridian Waste does NOT collect bulk goods.

# **Holiday Schedules**

If an observed holiday occurs on or prior to your scheduled collection day, services will be delayed one day for the remainder of the week.

# **Collection Day How-to Guide**


### **Cart Placement**

Carts should be **curbside by 6:00 AM** on your collection day.



### Step 1

Close the lid and roll cart to the curb. Point handle away from the street.



### Step 2

Place on the edge of the street next to the curb, at least 3 ft. away from all objects, including carts, cars, fences and mailboxes.

**ATTENTION:** All waste materials must be **INSIDE** the provided 95-gallon cart. Any items placed outside the cart will NOT be collected.

### **APPROVED Waste**

YES - Non-hazardous municipal solid waste

YES - Food scraps and food packaging

YES - Disposables

YES - Clothing

YES - Compost

YES - Bottles, cans and glass

YES - Newspapers & magazines

#### **NOT ACCEPTABLE**

No - Yard waste

**NO** — Hazardous Materials: Includes but not limited to: batteries, automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils), paint, lacquer, stain, thinner, varnish, wood preservatives, and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, pesticides and weed killer)

NO - Empty Hazardous Material Containers

**NO** — Electronic Waste: Includes but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens

NO - Radioactive Materials

NO - Biological/Medical Waste

NO - Liquids or water-soluble solids

NO - Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids

NO - Septic tank or chemical toilet waste

NO - Fluorescent light tubes and ballasts

NO - Automobile bodies
