Prepare for Pickup

Collection Day: To look up your specific collection days, please visit MeridianWaste.com/Find-My-Schedule or call Customer Care.

Set Out Time: 6:00 AM

Materials: All waste materials must be **BAGGED** and **INSIDE** your garbage cart. If an additional container is needed, customers may use their own cart/ can. For collection exceeding two carts, please call Customer Care, as additional fees may apply.

Weight Limits: Carts CANNOT exceed sixty (60) lb. each.


Holiday Schedule

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week.

Holidays Observed: New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Cart Placement

Carts MUST be **LESS THAN three (3) ft.** from the curb and MUST be **AT LEAST three (3) ft. away** from from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers).





All services are available by subscription. Call for details & pricing.

Garbage

- Collected weekly
- 95 gallon cart included with subscription
- Materials Accepted: Containerized, non-hazardous municipal solid waste

Recycling

- Collected every other Thursday
- 95 gallon cart included with subscription
- Materials Accepted: Plastic (Labeled #s 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7); aluminum and tin cans; mixed paper

Bulk Waste

- Call to schedule. Cost per item.
- Materials Accepted: Objects too big for the garbage cart, e.g., toilets, sinks, mattresses, carpet, fencing, and large household furnishings.
- Weight Limit: Safe for 2 people to pick up

White Goods

- Call to schedule. Cost per item.
- Materials Accepted: Stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc.
- Freon/refrigerant MUST be removed from appliances (refrigerators, freezers, etc.) before pickup.
- Weight Limit: Safe for 2 people to pick up

NO — Electronic Waste: Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens

- NO Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids
- **NO** Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids
- NO Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste
- **NO** Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts
- NO Automobile Bodies

RECYCLING CART

The following are accepted for curbside recycling: plastics (#s 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7); aluminum and tin cans; newspaper, magazines, junk mail, office paper, paper shopping bags, tissue or cereal boxes, and other clean cardboards.

NOTE: Items must be clean, with non-paper items rinsed and labels removed.



PLASTIC (Clear or Colored*) Label #s 1, 2, 3, 5 & 7 * NOT Accepted: #4, #6 & black plastics



ALUMINUM and TIN CANS





MIXED PAPER

NOT ACCEPTED CURBSIDE: PLASTIC BAGS and GLASS

Plastic bags and glass are not accepted in the curbside recycling program because they are common contaminants in the recycling stream.
