



Dried Paint Filters

Biosolids

Grease/Scum Waste

Wastewater Bio-Solids

Hydrofracking Waste

Hazardous Waste from Conditionally Exempt Small-Quantity Generators

Any Other Hard-to-Handle Material that is not Considered Hazardous Under RCRA

Cement Kiln Dust (CKD) Waste

The fine-grained solid by-product generated during the cement manufacturing process and captured by the facility's air pollution control system.

Crude Oil and Natural Gas Waste

Certain wastes from the exploration and production of oil, natural gas, and geothermal energy:

- Wastes brought to the surface during oil and gas exploration and production operations
- Wastes that have come into contact with the oil and gas production stream [e.g., materials used to process natural gas]

Fossil Fuel Combustion (FFC) Waste

FFC wastes produced from the burning of fossil fuels (i.e., coal, oil, natural gas), including fly ash, bottom ash, boiler slag, and particulates removed from flue gas

Separately Managed Coal Combustion Wastes

Large-volume coal combustion wastes generated at electric utility and independent power producing facilities that are managed separately

Co-Managed Coal Combustion Wastes

Large-volume coal combustion waste generated at electric utility and independent power producing facilities that are co-managed with certain other coal combustion wastes

All remaining FFC wastes, including:

- Coal combustion wastes generated at non-utilities
- Coal combustion wastes generated at facilities with fluidized bed combustion technology
- · Petroleum coke combustion wastes
- · Waste from the combustion of mixtures of coal and other fuels
- · Waste from the combustion of oil
- · Waste from the combustion of natural gas

Mining Waste

Most extraction and beneficiation wastes from hardrock mining (the mining of metallic ores and phosphate rock)

Mineral Processing Wastes

- Most mining wastes generated during the extraction, beneficiation, and processing of minerals
- · Iron blast furnace slag
- Slag from primary copper processing
- · Slag from elemental phosphorous production
- · Slag from primary lead processing
- Slag from primary zinc processing
- · Red and brown muds from bauxite refining
- Phosphogypsum from phosphoric acid production
- Flurogypsum from hydrofluoric acid production
- · Gasifier ash from coal gasification
- · Slag tailings from primary copper processing
- Calcium sulfate wastewater treatment plant sludge from primary copper processing
- Process wastewater from primary magnesium processing by the anhydrous process
- · Process wastewater from phosphoric acid production
- · Process wastewater from coal gasification
- · Process wastewater from hydrofluoric acid production
- Air pollution control dust/sludge from iron blast furnaces
- Treated residue from roasting/leaching of chrome ore
- Basic oxygen furnace and open hearth furnace air pollution control dust/ sludge from carbon steel production
- Basic oxygen furnace and open hearth furnace slag from carbon steel production
- Chloride process waste solids from titanium tetrachloride production
