# **Prepare for Pickup**

**Collection Day:** To determine your collection day, please call Bland County at [276] 688-4622.

**Collection Time:** Due by **7:00 AM** at designated collection point for your address (either multi-home pick-up point or curbside). Do **NOT** set trash out the night before or days before your collection day.

Materials: All trash should be **BAGGED** in proper trash bags. **Maximum** of seven (7) bags per week.

NO tires, batteries, car parts, chemicals, or any construction materials will be collected.

#### **Collection Point Guidelines**

Ensure garbage bags are placed roadside so as not to create any traffic hazards and to allow easy access (3 ft. clearance radius) for Meridian Waste to collect the bagged waste from the collection point, which may include enclosures made of wood or wire.





## Garbage

- Collected weekly
- Materials Accepted: Bagged, nonhazardous municipal solid waste

# Special/Large Items

- Collected during the first full week of the month
- Due at your collection point by 7 a.m. on your collection day
- Materials Accepted: Objects too big for the garbage cart, such as appliances and large household furnishings, etc.
- Weight Limit: Safe for 2 people to lift

### **APPROVED Waste**

YES - Non-hazardous municipal solid waste

**YES** — Food scraps and food packaging

YES - Disposables

YES - Compost

## **NOT ACCEPTABLE**

NO - Yard waste

**NO** — Hazardous Materials: Including but not limited to: batteries; automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils); paint and paint lacquer, stains, thinners, varnish and polishes; wood preservatives; and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, cleaners, solvents, adhesives; pesticides and weed killer)

NO - Empty Hazardous Material Containers

NO - Radioactive Materials

NO - Biological/Medical Waste

**NO** — Electronic Waste: Including but not limited to: TVs, computers, printers, DVD players, cell phones, and microwave ovens

NO - Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids

NO - Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids

NO - Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste

NO - Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts

NO - Automobile Parts & Bodies
