## A Slip Sliding Success at the Meridian Waste Shotwell Environmental Park's Summer Splash Bash

The event featured a special guest, former North Carolina Secretary of State Rufus Edmisten, who participated and volunteered as an impromptu food server to feed the hungry visitors.
