PLASTICS (Clear or Non-Black) Label #s 1 and 2



ALUMINUM CANS



MIXED PAPER



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD



Recycling only works when items are easy to separate and reuse and match what the facility is able to process.

Unfortunately, **when wrong or unaccepted items are mixed in**, the recycling becomes "contaminated" and **causes more harm than good**.

Contamination **not only ruins the whole batch** leaving no choice but to send all of it to the **landfill** it can also **damage equipment**, **harm workers**, and **adds additional expenses and disposal costs**.

NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING


IMPORTANT: NO GLASS items of **ANY** kind

- NO Plastic bags, plastic wrap, tin foil, styrofoam
- **NO** Soiled/food-contaminated recyclable items (such as greasy pizza boxes or peanut butter still left in the jar)
- NO Batteries
- NO Household Garbage, Yard Waste or other municipal solid waste
- NO Hazardous Materials and/or Their Containers, including but not limited to: batteries, paint, chemicals of any kind
- **NO** Biological/Medical Waste
- NO Electronic Waste (such as TVs, computers, cell phones, charging cables, fluorescent light bulbs)
