Collection Day: Call Customer Care for Collection Day.

Set Out Time: 6:00 AM

**Materials:** All waste materials must be **INSIDE** the provided cart (i.e., garbage in garbage cart, recycling in recycling cart). Items placed outside the cart will NOT be collected. (Extra carts may be requested for an additional monthly fee.)

Weight Limits: Carts CANNOT exceed sixty (60) lb. each.


## **Holiday Schedule**

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week.

**Holidays Observed:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

## **Cart Placement**

Carts MUST be **LESS THAN** three (3) ft. from the curb and MUST be **AT LEAST three** (3) ft. away from from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers).





All services are available by subscription. Call for details & pricing.

### Garbage

- Collected weekly
- 95 gallon cart included in subscription; additional carts available for a fee
- Materials Accepted: Containerized, nonhazardous municipal solid waste.

## Recycling

- Collected weekly
- 65 gallon cart included in subscription
- Materials Accepted: Plastic (Labeled #s 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7); aluminum, tin, and steel cans; mixed paper

### **Yard Waste**

- Collected weekly (March-November)
- Customer-provided can, biodegradable bags or bundles
- 9- or 3-month programs available
- Materials Accepted: Leaves, grass, small limbs and branches
- Weight Limit: 60 lb. per can or bag

### **Bulk Waste**

- Call to schedule. Cost per item.
- Materials Accepted: Objects too big for the garbage cart, e.g., toilets, sinks, mattresses, carpet, fencing, and large household furnishings.
- Weight Limit: Safe for two men to pick up

### White Goods

- Call to schedule. Cost per item.
- Materials Accepted: Stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc.
- Weight Limit: Safe for two men to pick up



## **ATTENTION:** All materials must be **INSIDE** the appropriate cart. Any items placed outside the cart will NOT be collected.

## **GARBAGE CART**

### **APPROVED Waste**

YES - Non-hazardous municipal solid waste

**YES** — Food scraps and food packaging

YES - Disposables

YES — Clothing

YES - Compost

YES - Bottles, cans, newspapers & magazines

YES - Glass

### NOT ACCEPTABLE

NO - Tires

NO - Yard waste

NO — Hazardous Materials: Including but not limited to: batteries; automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils); paint and paint lacquer, stains, thinners, varnish and polishes; wood preservatives; and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, cleaners, solvents, adhesives; pesticides and weed killer)

NO - Empty Hazardous Material Containers

NO - Radioactive Materials

NO - Biological/Medical Waste

NO — Electronic Waste: Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens

NO - Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids

NO - Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids

NO - Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste

NO - Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts

NO - Automobile Bodies

## **RECYCLING CARTS**

The following are accepted for curbside recycling: plastics (#s 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7); aluminum, tin, and steel cans; newspaper, magazines, junk mail, office paper, tissue or cereal boxes, and other clean cardboards.

**NOTE:** Items must be clean, with non-paper items rinsed and labels removed.

\*NOT Accepted: #4, #6 & black plastics

### **NOT ACCEPTED CURBSIDE: GLASS**

Glass is not accepted in the curbside recycling program due to it being a common contaminant in the recycling stream.
