# City of Lake Saint Louis Collection Guidelines

## **Prepare for Pickup**

Collection Day: Call Customer Care for Collection Day.

Set Out Time: 6:00 AM

**Materials:** All waste materials must be **INSIDE** the provided cart (i.e., garbage in the garbage cart, recycling in the recycling cart). Items placed outside the cart will NOT be collected. (An extra 95-gallon cart may be requested for an additional monthly fee.) To help contain litter, please bag waste before placing it in the garbage cart. Do NOT bag recycling.

Weight Limits: Carts CANNOT exceed sixty (60) lb. each.


## **Holiday Schedule**

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week.

**Holidays Observed:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

### **Cart Placement**

Carts MUST be LESS THAN three (3) ft. from the curb and MUST be AT LEAST three (3) ft. away from from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers).





Hazardous waste will NOT be collected.

## Garbage

- Collected weekly
- 95-gallon cart
- Materials Accepted: Containerized, nonhazardous municipal solid waste

## Recycling

- Collected weekly
- 95-, 65- and 35-gallon Meridian Waste recycle cart
- Flattened boxes can be placed next to the container when container is full and boxes measure less than 3 ft by 3ft in length.
   Do NOT place boxes inside of each other for collection.

### **Yard Waste**

- Collected weekly
- Bag (biodegradable paper) or containerize all loose material
- Materials Accepted: Leaves, grass, limbs and branches (bundled) less than 5 ft. in length or 6 in. diameter
- Weight Limit: 60 lb. per can or bag

### **Bulk Waste**

- One item per week at no charge, \$20 per additional item. Call to schedule.
- Materials Accepted: Large items like toilets, sinks, mattresses, carpet, fencing, and big household furnishings
- Weight Limit: Safe for two people to pick up

### White Goods

- Call to schedule. Cost per item.
- Materials Accepted: Stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc.
- Weight Limit: Safe for two people to pick up

## **GARBAGE CART**

#### **APPROVED Waste**

YES - Non-hazardous municipal solid waste

YES - Food scraps and food packaging

YES - Disposables

YES - Clothing

YES - Compost

YES - Bottles, cans, newspapers & magazines

YES - Glass

### **NOT ACCEPTABLE**

NO - Tires

NO - Yard waste

NO — Hazardous Materials: Including but not limited to: batteries; automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils); paint and paint lacquer, stains, thinners, varnish and polishes; wood preservatives; and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, cleaners, solvents, adhesives; pesticides and weed killer)

NO - Empty Hazardous Material Containers

NO - Radioactive Materials

NO - Biological/Medical Waste

**NO** — Electronic Waste: Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens

NO - Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids

NO - Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids

NO - Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste

NO - Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts

NO - Automobile Bodies

## **RECYCLING CART**

The following are accepted for curbside recycling: plastics (#s 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7); aluminum, tin, and steel cans; newspaper, magazines, junk mail, office paper, cereal boxes, and other clean cardboards.

**NOTE:** Items must be clean, with non-paper items rinsed and labels removed.

\*NOT Accepted: #4, #6 & black plastics

### **NOT ACCEPTED CURBSIDE: GLASS**

Glass is not accepted in the curbside recycling program due to it being a common contaminant in the recycling stream.
