Prepare for Pickup

Collection Day: Garbage collected **weekly on WEDNESDAY**.

Set Out Time: **Place cart curbside the night before** your collection day.

Materials: All waste materials must be **BAGGED** and **INSIDE** your garbage cart at the designated collection location, in a spot that is readily accessible. If an extra cart is needed, please call the Town of Burkeville at **(434) 767-4095** for more information and pricing details.

Service Alerts: Sign up for email and/or text alerts so we can notify you in the event of inclement weather, holidays, or other factors that might interrupt your service. Sign up at: MeridianWaste.com/Service-Alert-Signup

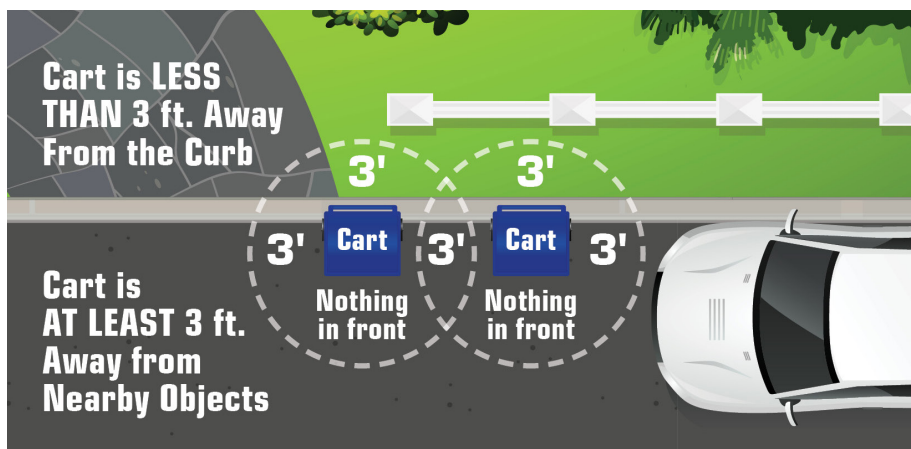
Holiday Schedule

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week.

Holidays Observed: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day (July 4th), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day

Cart Placement

Carts **MUST** be **LESS THAN three (3) ft.** from the curb and **MUST** be **AT LEAST three (3) ft. away** from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers).



All services are available by subscription.

Garbage

- Collected **weekly on WEDNESDAY**.
- 96-gallon cart included with subscription. Extra carts available for a fee.
- **Materials Accepted:** Bagged & containerized non-hazardous municipal solid waste.

Yard Waste

- Collection available for an additional fee. Please ask for details when scheduling.
- Collection must be **scheduled at least five (5) business days in advance** via the phone number or email listed below.
- **Weight Limit:** 50 lb. per bundle/bag.
- **Materials Accepted:** Vegetative items that are no longer than 4 ft. in length and 4" inches in diameter.
- All leaves and small debris **MUST** be bagged or containerized. Limbs meeting the size restrictions must be neatly stacked or tied.
- **NOT Accepted:** **NO** tree trunks or stumps will be collected. **NO** commercially produced yard waste generated by a professional for hire contractor will be collected.

Bulk Waste

- Collection available for an additional fee. Please ask for details when scheduling.
- Collection must be **scheduled at least five (5) business days in advance** via the phone number or email listed below. Pick-up will be on your normal service day.
- **Materials Accepted:** Large items like sofas, chairs, washers, dryers, toilets, sinks, mattresses, carpet, fencing, etc.
- **NOT Accepted:** Hazardous waste and any construction or demolition debris.
- **Weight Limit:** Safe for two people to lift.

ATTENTION: All waste materials must be **BAGGED** and placed **INSIDE** your cart in the designated collection location, in a spot that is readily accessible.

GARBAGE

APPROVED Waste

- YES** — Non-hazardous municipal solid waste
- YES** — Food scraps and food packaging
- YES** — Disposables
- YES** — Clothing
- YES** — Compost
- YES** — *Bottles, cans, newspapers & magazines
- YES** — *Glass

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- NO** — Tires
- NO** — Yard waste
- NO** — **Hazardous Materials:** Including but not limited to: batteries; automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils); paint and paint lacquer, stains, thinners, varnish and polishes; wood preservatives; and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, cleaners, solvents, adhesives; pesticides and weed killer)
- NO** — Empty Hazardous Material Containers
- NO** — Radioactive Materials
- NO** — Biological/Medical Waste
- NO** — **Electronic Waste:** Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens
- NO** — Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids
- NO** — Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids
- NO** — Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste
- NO** — Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts
- NO** — Automobile Bodies

FIRE & EXPLOSION DANGER: LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES

Lithium-ion batteries should **NEVER** be placed in any **GARBAGE OR RECYCLING** containers. They store so much high energy that — *even if they seem dead* — they **frequently cause fires** and **can even explode** when crushed!

Lithium-ion Batteries

Examples: Cell phones, laptops, tablets, power banks, cameras.

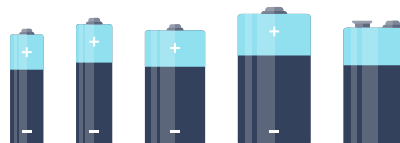
NEVER OK in Garbage or Recycling! These are Hazardous Waste and require safe disposal.



Alkaline & Zinc-Carbon Batteries

Examples: 9-Volt, AA, AAA, C, D.

Generally OK in trash if ends are taped (see website).
