Collection Guidelines

Prepare for Pickup

Collection Day: Once per week. To find out your specific collection day, please visit **MeridianWaste.com/ChambersCoAL** or contact Customer Care.

Set Out Time: Carts must be **placed curbside the night before or by 6:00 AM** on your collection day to ensure service.

Materials: All trash must be BAGGED, TIED, and contained INSIDE your 95-gallon Meridian Waste garbage cart to limit trash spillage during collection. Only the contents of the cart will be collected. (NOTE: The week after a holiday, we will also collect up to 3 extra 30-gallon bags or bundles (48" or less), and weighing less than 50 lb each. Please place neatly beside the cart.) To help with excess bags, customers can order an extra cart; contact Customer Care for details.

Holiday Schedule

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week.

Holidays Observed: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day (July 4th), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Cart Placement

Carts MUST be **LESS THAN** five (5) ft. from the curb and MUST be **AT LEAST five** (5) ft. away from any nearby standing objects (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers). Arrange so that the lid and front of the cart are facing the road, while the handle points at the curb.

Collection fees are billed quarterly in advance and payment is to be made directly to Meridian Waste. Invoices must be paid in full to maintain uninterrupted service.
