Collection Guidelines

Collection Day: Garbage and Recycling collection is **WEDNESDAY**. All carts should be **curbside by 6:00 AM**.

Materials: All waste materials must be **INSIDE** the provided cart (garbage in the garbage cart, recycling in the recycling cart). Items placed outside the cart will NOT be collected. (Extra carts may be requested for an additional monthly fee.)

Weight Limits: Carts CANNOT exceed fifty (50) lb. each.


Holiday Schedule

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week.

Holidays Observed: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Cart Placement

Carts MUST be **WITHIN** three (3) ft. of the curb and MUST be **AT LEAST** three (3) ft. away from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers).





Garbage

- Collected weekly
- 95 gallon cart
- Materials Accepted: Containerized, non-hazardous municipal solid waste

Single Stream Recycling

- Collected weekly
- 65-gallon cart
- Materials Accepted: See next page or local website

Yard Waste

- March-November: Collected weekly on Wednesday
 December-February: Call Meridian
 Waste to schedule
- Materials Accepted: Leaves, grass, small limbs and branches—you MUST containerize all loose material or tie with natural fiber twine.
- Maximum six (6) containers, bundled stacks, or biodegradable bags per week, no more than 50 lb. each.
- Size Limits: Total volume limited to 3 cubic yd. Bundles not to exceed 3 feet in length and 4 inches in diameter.

Bulk Waste

- Call to (314) 291-3131 to schedule.
- Up to two items are collected at no charge on the last Friday of the month.
- Materials Accepted: "Bulky" items are objects over fifty (50) lb and/or those too big for the garbage cart, such as toilets, sinks, bicycles, mattresses, carpet, fencing, and large household furnishings
- Weight Limit: Safe for two people to lift

NO - Electronic Waste: Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens

NO - Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids

NO Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids

- Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste

- Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts

NO Automobile Bodies

RECYCLING CART

Materials Accepted: Plastics labeled #s 1 and 2: aluminum. tin, and steel cans; flattened cardboard with tape removed; fiberboard; newspaper (including inserts); and mixed paper (magazines, office paper, mail, etc.)

*NOT Accepted: Black plastics

NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

The following items are considered contaminants to this type of recycling stream and WILL NOT be accepted: Glass, Plastic Bags, and Food-contaminated Boxes or Packaging (items such as greasy pizza boxes or peanut butter jars that aren't completely washed out).

RECYCLING DROP-OFF

Mixed paper and cardboard (flattened) can be dropped off for recycling; these materials MUST be separated from other items and placed in the designated container set up at the drop-off location.
