

# Shenandoah Valley Hauling Open Residential Subscription Collection Guidelines

## Prepare for Pickup

**Collection Day:** To look up your specific collection days, please visit [MeridianWaste.com/ShenandoahValley](https://MeridianWaste.com/ShenandoahValley) or call Customer Care.

**Set Out Time:** Place carts curbside **THE NIGHT BEFORE** your scheduled collection day.

**Materials:** All waste must be containerized (**INSIDE** a cart/toter or garbage bag). Loose garbage will NOT be collected.

**Weight & Bag Limits:** Weight **CANNOT** exceed fifty (50) lb. each (one person must be able to lift). If no cart, there is a six (6) bag limit. Carts can be rented from Meridian Waste; please contact Customer Care for details.

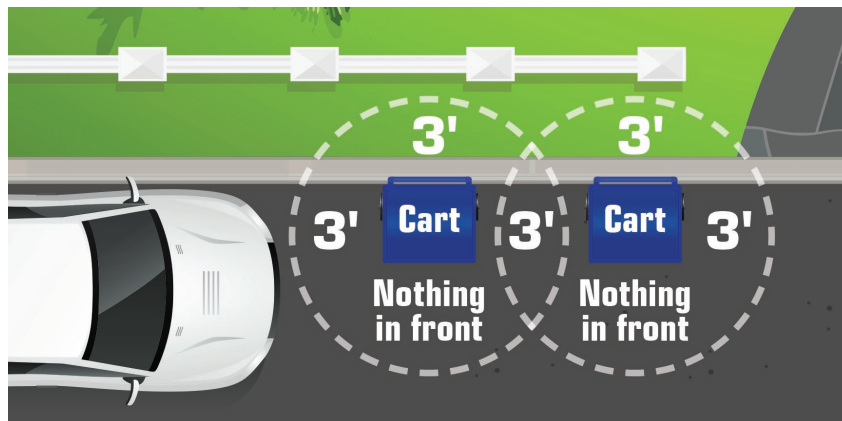
## Holiday Schedule

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no change in the regular collection schedule. Any changes will be communicated via our service alert system!

**Holidays Observed:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

## Cart/Toter & Garbage Bag Placement

Items for pick-up MUST be **LESS THAN three (3) ft.** from the curb or collection site and MUST be **AT LEAST three (3) ft. away** from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers).



## Garbage

- Collected **weekly**
- Materials Accepted: Containerized and bagged non-hazardous municipal solid waste

### APPROVED Waste

- YES** – Non-hazardous municipal solid waste
- YES** – Food scraps and food packaging
- YES** – Disposables
- YES** – Clothing
- YES** – Compost
- YES** – Bottles, cans, newspapers & magazines
- YES** – Glass

### NOT ACCEPTABLE

- NO** – Tires
- NO** – Yard waste
- NO** – **Hazardous Materials:** Including but not limited to: batteries; automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils); paint and paint lacquer, stains, thinners, varnish and polishes; wood preservatives; and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, cleaners, solvents, adhesives; pesticides and weed killer)
- NO** – **Empty Hazardous Material Containers**
- NO** – **Radioactive Materials**
- NO** – **Biological/Medical Waste**
- NO** – **Dead Animals**
- NO** – **Electronic Waste:** Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens
- NO** – Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids
- NO** – Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids
- NO** – Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste
- NO** – Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts
- NO** – Automobile Bodies
