



Disposal Rate Increase Notice

Dear Valued Nassau County Hauling Residential & Commercial Customers,

Effective October 1, 2026, Meridian Waste will implement a service rate adjustment for residential and commercial customers due to increased disposal costs at the Camden County Landfill in Georgia. Nassau County no longer operates a municipal solid waste landfill, and the City of Jacksonville currently does not accept out-of-county waste for disposal. As a result, Camden County Landfill remains the most economical disposal option currently available for the waste Meridian Waste collects in Nassau, Camden and Charlton Counties. Camden County has recently increased its disposal rates, directly increasing Meridian Waste's cost to provide collection and disposal services.

The new out-of-county disposal rate has increased 33.5%, from \$27.89 to \$41.90 per ton.

We appreciate your understanding as we work to manage these increased costs while continuing to provide safe, reliable and cost-effective waste services to our Nassau County Hauling customers.
